CAREER COUNSELORS NEEDED

Looking for hard-charging First and Second Class Petty Officers with Career Counselor experience to apply for a rating conversion to NC. Applicants must currently be Active Duty with 6 to 14 years of active Naval service; have no marks below 3.0 in the previous three years performance evaluations; have an ASVAB test score of VE+AR=105, minimum 50 AR; and have at least 12 consecutive months experience as a command, departmental or divisional career counselor during the previous three years prior to application date. Additional guidance is outlined in MILPERSMAN 1440-020.

SECB RESULTS POSTED

Board results for the FY15 Senior Enlisted Continuation Board have been approved and posted on BOL for Command Triads. Of the 7,017 eligible candidates, 98 percent (or 6,854) of candidates were selected for continuation. On 3 February, complete results will be posted on BOL so all Sailors may check their results. Active Duty and Full-Time Support Sailors not selected for continuation must transfer to the Fleet Reserve or retire by 31 August, unless operationally waived to remain on active status by Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel by 30 November.
