Review the eligibility criteria and ensure that interested applicants meet all criteria before submitting a package. Remember that the submitted package is a direct reflection of the applicant; ensure there are no typos! EDIVO MOBILE APP FOR DIVOS AND CPOS AVAILABLE

ENLISTED EARLY TRANSITION PROGRAM QUOTA UPDATE

A good question to ask before viewing sensitive and classified information is "Do I have a need to know?" Viewing information unrelated to your Need to Know is a direct violation of the Privacy Act. REMINDER TO TRACK I TEMPO

Per NAVADMIN 335/12, all service member deployment days are required to be tracked in PERSTEMPO. All commands and activities are required to continue reporting PERSTEMPO events for ALL assigned Sailors. Not all commands have been accurately accounting for their Sailors' PERSTEMPO Deployment days. This data is used to facilitate the assignment process for both PCS and IA orders; to answer queries by Congress, Department of Defense and other agencies; and most importantly, in allocating HDP-T pay.
