CORE SKILL REQUIREMENTS FOR: Joint Operational Logistics/3212

Billet subspecialty coding is to be based on the minimum education/training/experience level required for optimum performance. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 subspecialty coding is justified when, in addition to the general criteria stated in NAVPERS 15839 series (Manual of Navy Officer Manpower and Personnel Classification) Part B, the following specific criteria are satisfied:

1. Subspecialty Coding Restrictions: Billets assigned to:
U.S. Navy Officers.
2. Applicable Officer Designator(s): Billets assigned to:
U.S. Navy and International Officers.
3. Applicable Billet Designator(s): 3212
4. Significant Experience Criteria:
 - a. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 S-coded Billets are authorized.
 - b. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 S-coded Officers are authorized.
 - c. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 R-coded Billets are authorized.
 - d. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 R-coded Officers are authorized.
5. Baccalaureate Criteria:
 - a. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 E-coded Billets are not authorized.
 - b. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 E-coded Officers are not authorized.
6. Elective Level Criteria: Joint Operational Logistics/3212 H-coded Billets are authorized.

7. Functional Education Criteria:

a. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 F-coded Billets are not authorized.

b. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 G-coded Officers are not authorized.

8. Masters Criteria for Joint Operational Logistics/3212:

a. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 P-coded Billets are authorized.

b. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 P-coded Officers are justified when:

(1) The Officer completes Joint Operational Logistics/3212 ESRs.

(2) Full Subspecialty will not be given if Thesis or Project is not completed. Utilization and obligations are still required.

c. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 Q-coded Billets are authorized.

d. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 Q-coded Officers are authorized.

9. Post Masters:

a. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 N-coded Billets are not authorized.

b. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 N-coded Officers are not authorized.

c. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 M-coded Billets are not authorized.

d. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 M-coded Officers are not authorized.

10. Doctorate Criteria:

a. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 D-coded Billets are not authorized.

b. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 D-coded Officers are not authorized.

c. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 C-coded Billets are not authorized.

d. Joint Operational Logistics/3212 C-coded Officers are not authorized.

11. Community Manager and the Budget Submitting Office have agreed to allow Officers to be educated for Joint Operational Logistics/3212.


